Course Objective

- Semester 2: complete Book 1 (Lesson 10-Lesson 15) and Book 2 (Lesson 1-Lesson 5) and pass final grade of corresponding level
- Semester 3: complete Book 2 (Lesson 6-Lesson 15) and be ready to take “Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOFCL) Listening & Reading” Level 2

Class Hours

3 hours each meeting/3 meetings per week/15 weeks per semester/Semester 1, 2, 3

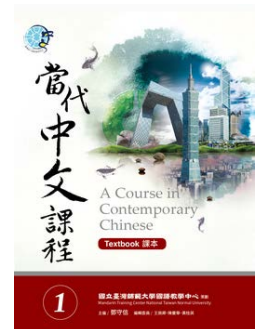
Fourth semester, summer and winter break: no class (self-study)

Grade

We use final grade to assess students' learning result of current

semester as well as **suitability to take the class of the following semester.**

Passing grade is 80 (out of 100). Student will be notified of final grade within two weeks of final exam.

Passing TOFCL is not mandatory by ICDF. However, if students hope to take this test, they should attentively check TOCFL test schedule and register appropriate test on time. Scholarship will cover test fee one time.

Policy

TaiwanICDF scholarship program does not require students to attend Chinese class. Your participation is entirely voluntary; however, it is strongly encouraged that you take advantage of the opportunity to learn this language that could be useful for a better adjustment in the new environment and your further career. When you decide to take the Chinese class, you will be expected to perform at a desired level of commitment and learning result. The following policy will be in place to help you achieve course objectives and make sure that students are fully committed.

1. A sign-up by email or Facebook message is required from every student who wants to enroll class. Before signing up, students should make sure that they are fully committed.
2. **A deposit of NTD 2,000** to guarantee your attendance is required, and it would be fully returned to those who **do not miss class hours more than 15 hours** in the end of the semester.
3. Students are expected to be on time for every class. **Late arrival of 15 minutes or being absent in the middle of class more than 15 minutes count as absence of that whole hour.**
4. **To ensure learning quality, those who miss classes more than 15 hours would not be allowed to attend the rest of the class any more and the deposit won't be returned either.**
5. **Student MUST achieve score at least 80 out of 100 in final grade to be eligible to take the class in the following semester.** In case you fail to attain either of two requirements (grade and participation), you will no longer be accepted to Chinese classes (including repeating a class) sponsored by TaiwanICDF scholarship.
